ARTICLE XI. AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS

Amendments to all articles of these constitutional bylaws may be made if proposed at a general meeting of the WFCFA and passed by a 2/3 vote of the membership present at two consecutive general meetings.

Amendments to all articles of these constitutional bylaws may be made if proposed via written or printed notice stating the specific wording of the change and given to the members entitled to vote at a general meeting of the WFCFA not less than three weeks before the date of such meeting. Amendments to the constitutional bylaws must be passed by 2/3 vote of the membership present at two consecutive general meetings.

Amendments to all articles of the operational bylaws may be made if proposed via written or printed notice stating the specific wording of the change and given to the members entitled to vote at a general meeting of the WFCFA not less than three weeks before the date of such meeting. Amendments to the operational bylaws must be passed by majority vote of the membership present at that general meeting.
